## Picking your program



There is a lot of different software options out there to use for DJs, but it's important you pick one that works with your device and your DJ Controller (deck). Most DJ Controllers come with software included.

### Traktor DJ 2

A professional DJ software developed by Native Instruments and works on Windows & Mac. It has a lot of customization options, which can be a little confusing for beginners, but it is free and offers a lot of features.

### Rekordbox

It works with Windows & Mac and is designed to work with Pioneer DJ gear - which is often an industry standard. Connects with online sound libraries in SoundCloud and dropbox when performing live.

### Serato Lite

Great for starting and working with Computers (Windows & Mac) and Tablets - great for schools with BYOD. It will work on computers without a lot of memory and has enough features to get students up and running. The full (paid) Serato software is also an industry standard.

### Algoriddim DJay

Originally for iPads, this has been expanded to include Macs, tablets, Chromebooks and Windows devices. It's great for learning and minimises your hardware spending when starting up.
